



REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

The Four Rivers Nuclear Partnership (FRNP), in support of the Department of Energy Portsmouth/Paducah Project Office (PPPO), is seeking information on potential subcontractor interest in providing design engineering services to the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant (PGDP).

THIS IS A REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (RFI) ONLY. This RFI is issued solely for information and planning purposes – it does not constitute a Request for Proposal (RFP) or a promise to issue an RFP in the future. This request for information does not commit Four Rivers Nuclear Partnership, LLC (FRNP) to contract for supply or service whatsoever. Further, FRNP is not at this time seeking proposals and will not accept unsolicited proposals. Those wishing to respond are advised that FRNP will not pay for information or administrative costs incurred in response to this RFI; costs associated with responding to this RFI will be solely at the interested party's expense. Not responding to this RFI does not preclude participation in future RFPs, if any are issued. If a solicitation is released, it will be sent to the qualifying Vendor(s).

1. Description of Anticipated Subcontract

- Design engineering, engineering studies, engineering support, and project integration in support of construction of a potential On-Site Waste Disposal Facility (OSWDF) under CERCLA at the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant site near Paducah, Kentucky. The potential OSWDF would provide for waste disposition of low level radioactive, mixed low level radioactive, and Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) waste within the boundaries of the PGDP site. The anticipated subcontract will be multi-year with options. The 30% and the 60% OSWDF Design will be developed in parallel with the Waste Disposition Alternative (WDA) RI/FS Report that will evaluate the potential for on-site disposal.

2. Requested Information

- Interested parties are requested to respond to this RFI with a Capability Statement including experience in landfill design, experience with CERCLA RI/FS evaluations and the Remedial Design/Remedial Action process, and/or experience on DOE sites.
- A brief description of the company's capabilities for completing the proposed type of work included in this RFI
- A brief description of the Quality Assurance program the company has established
- Responses are due no later than **1:00pm CT, 07/22/2024**. Responses shall be submitted via e-mail only to Amanda.Hatton@pad.pppo.gov. Proprietary information, if any, should be minimized and **MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED**.

- FRNP representatives may or may not choose to discuss the RFI with interested parties. Such discussions would only be intended to get further clarification of potential capability to meet the requirements.
