Four Rivers Nuclear Partnership, LLC Paducah Deactivation and Remediation Project

Evacuation of Liquid Propane and Off-site Removal for Disposition

The requested work is in support of Four Rivers Nuclear Partnership, LLC (FRNP), managing the Paducah Deactivation and Remediation (D&R) project, under Task Order DE-EM0004895 with the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE).

FRNP, a contractor of DOE is seeking Expressions of Interest (EOIs) solely for information and planning of the path forward for an upcoming project.

This project is to perform evacuation and removal of approximately 500-600 gallons of liquid propane from two 500 gallon propane tanks previously associated with the C-400 back-up generator system; and includes off-site transport/removal of the reclaimed liquid propane for disposition.

This EOI is not an Invitation for Bid (IFB) or Request for Proposal (RFP) and does not constitute any commitment for future solicitation. All costs associated with providing information in response to this EOI shall be the sole responsibility of the interested party.

All information received in response to this EOI will be managed as procurement sensitive. Additionally, information marked PROPRIETARY will be handled accordingly. FRNP will share and discuss with DOE our evaluation of all EOIs. DOE may participate in any discussions with responding parties.

Background

Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant (PGDP) is located in Paducah, Kentucky and situated on approximately 3,420 acres, 3.5 miles south of the Ohio River. Owned by DOE, the plant was constructed in the 1950's for the purpose of enriching uranium.

Scope of Work (Draft)

Perform complete evacuation of approximately 500-600 gallons of liquid propane from two 500 gallon propane tanks (disconnected and gapped) for future tank disposal.

Conduct off-site transport and removal of the reclaimed liquid propane once evacuated from both tanks for disposition.

All liquid propane shall be evacuated and contained from open air dispersion in accordance with all State and Federal laws.

All liquid propane shall be transported in accordance with all State and Federal laws.

All work shall be in compliance with FRNP policies and procedures.

Interested parties are invited to submit an EOI for the scope of work. At minimum, the following should be submitted:

Capability Statement containing administrative information

- d. Describe any capabilities your company had, has planned, or would need to initiate.

- ii. Quality Assurance Program (NQA-1, ISO 9000, QS-9000, EIA-599, or otherwise) and certifications
- iii. State and Federal Licenses/Certifications
- iv. Staffing Capabilities
