



REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

The Four Rivers Nuclear Partnership (FRNP), in support of the Department of Energy Portsmouth/Paducah Project Office (PPPO), is seeking information on potential vendor interest in supplying cargo containers to the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant (PGDP).

THIS IS A REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (RFI) ONLY. This RFI is issued solely for information and planning purposes – it does not constitute a Request for Proposal (RFP) or a promise to issue an RFP in the future. This request for information does not commit Four Rivers Nuclear Partnership, LLC (FRNP) to contract for supply or service whatsoever. Further, FRNP is not at this time seeking proposals and will not accept unsolicited proposals. Those wishing to respond are advised that FRNP will not pay for information or administrative costs incurred in response to this RFI; costs associated with responding to this RFI will be solely at the interested party's expense. Not responding to this RFI does not preclude participation in future RFPs, if any are issued. If a solicitation is released, it will be sent to the qualifying Vendor(s).

1. Description of Anticipated Purchase

- IP-1 Cargo Containers – Specifically High Cube Sealands for waste disposition
- Estimated Quantity: up to 500
- Estimated Size: LxWxH: 20' X 8' X 9'6"

2. Requested Information

- Interested parties are requested to respond to this RFI with a Capability Statement.
- A brief description of the company's capabilities for completing the proposed type of work included in this RFI.
- A brief description of the Quality Assurance program the company has established
- A statement on the expected country of manufacture and if the sealands that could be supplied would comply with the Buy American Act FAR Clause 52.225-1.
- Responses are due no later than **02/25/2022 at 4:30pm CST**. Responses shall be submitted via e-mail only to Amanda.Hatton@pad.pppo.gov. Proprietary information, if any, should be minimized and **MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED**.

3. Responses

- FRNP representatives may or may not choose to discuss the RFI with interested parties. Such discussions would only be intended to get further clarification of potential capability to meet the requirements.
